

FESTIVAL RULES

- No alcohol is to be bought into the main site. Alcohol is only permitted in the camping area.
- Sundogs Festival operates a zero-tolerance policy on illegal substances.
- The whole site is a no-glass zone.
- The ticket gate will be closed at 8pm on Friday and Saturday evenings. There will be no entry to the site after these times.
- The camping car park will be closed at 8pm and reopened at 8am the following morning (Friday and Saturday).
- You will only receive an Over 18 wristband with a valid photo ID. **NO ID NO Over 18 WRISTBAND!**
- Any persons under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult over the age of 21. **ALL U18S MUST BE OFF SITE BY 8.00PM.**
- Festival wristbands must be worn at all times - anybody without a wristband will be removed.
- All bags and camping bags will be subject to a search, and any prohibited items will be confiscated. All festival attendees are subjected to be searched at any time.
- No BBQS or open fires are allowed on the site and will be removed.
- We ask that all festival goers are considerate of our local community and other festival goers and campers.
- The whole site is a NO DOG zone.
- Luctonians does not accept responsibility for the loss or damage to a person's property.
- Anybody being found abusive to staff, volunteers, or other festival attendees will be removed from the site.
- **We have the right to refuse entry or remove anybody from the festival.**



CAMPING RULES

- The campsite area is restricted to over 18s.
- Only individuals wearing a camping wristband are permitted to enter into the campsite - Wristbands must be worn at all times.
- Alcohol cannot be brought into the main area from the campsite.
- NO GLASS- No glass is to be brought on site at all. There are no exceptions.
- We have a no-naked flame policy at the festival and in the campsite. Fires, Flares, Fireworks, BBQs, and Chinese Lanterns will be extinguished.

- All music must be kept to a reasonable level.
- No vehicles are allowed in the campsite.
