Sundogs Festival works hard to ensure that we leave as little mark on the local land and areas during and after our festival.

We work hard to ensure that we are sustainable and keep our impact on the environment minimum.

- We need your help to ensure we are doing everything possible to reduce our carbon footprint.
- To minimise plastic waste all our bars are operated with plastic reusable cups and paper straws. Cup collection points and a sweep of the ground to collect dropped cups operates throughout the day.
- All food vendors and external suppliers are advised to use local produce where available and to always use recyclable containers. We also make sure we have sufficient vegan and vegetarian options available.
- Please use our bins provided. Recycling bins are in operation throughout the site. All rubbish is recycled or disposed of correctly.
- Please use the toilets provided, urinating on the land can have serious implications for the land.
- Please only use what you need – Please do not leave showers or taps running, be mindful of our water usage.
- Take your tents and equipment home with you. Did you know that the amount of plastic in a single tent is the equivalent of 8,750 plastic straws, or 250 pint cups? Say no to single-use, take your tent home!
- Please use public transport or car share to the festival. We also encourage our staff and volunteer to car share to the festival.
- Please bring a reusable water bottle – we have water taps across the site where you can refill your bottles. 90% of the water supply to the festival is from a borehole on site.
- Please do not bring in glass bottles or prohibited items – these can cause serious damage to the land and people that use the site after the festival.
